

SEVILLA- SAHARA 29 APRIL 2020 FERIA DE SEVILLA 5 DAYS

DEPARTURE DATE: April 29[™], 2020

Wednesday APRIL 29[™], 2020 SEVILLA - CHEFCHAOUEN - MEKNES 05:45 hrs. Assemble in Seville, Prado de San Sebastián

06:00 hrs Depart to Algeciras; get the return tickets for the ferry.

Board the ferry to Tanger Med, Morocco.

09:00 hrs Ferry leaves Algeciras. *Make sure to bring your passport. During the journey you have to stamp your passport at the Moroccan police desk.

Upon arrival in Tanger Med we will travel to Chefchaouen, an unforgettable little BLUE town in the Rif mountains. Its blue and white houses form a labyrinth of vivid colors not to be missed.

Guided visit to points of interest.

Afterwards you will have some free time to eat and then travel to Meknes.

Arrival in Meknes and visit Bab el Mansur and the market.

Arrival to the hotel, Check in and dinner in the hotel.

THURSDAY APRIL 30™, 2020 MEKNES - MERZOUGA

Breakfast and check out.

Depart for the south of Morocco to the Sahara desert, crossing the middle atlas –where you can see the wild apes- and the high Atlas. Stop on route to eat and continue to the oasis of Merzouga where you get your first taste of the Sahara. Its dunes stretch infinitely into the horizon and some rise more than 150 meters skyward.

Arrival to the desert.

In the evening camel trek in the dunes and free evening to enjoy the Sahara.

Dinner on haimas.

We spend the night in haimas (communal tents) in the desert.



FRIDAY MAY 1st, 2020 SAHARA TOTAL

Early wake up call into the Erg Chigaga dunes for sunrise. We guarantee that the experience of a Saharan sunrise is well worth the journey. It is absolutely breathtaking. This is one of the highlights of the trip and a memorable way to start this day.

Breakfast

Half-day excursion in 4X4 to Merzouga and the Great Erg Chebi "Desert of Dunes of the Finest Sand in which we will see the virgin desert, we will pass by the small oasis visited by the Berber nomads, the hamada (desert of stones) and places where fossils of millions of years old are found. During this trip in 4x4 we will make the stops you want to take pictures, walk and observe anything that catches your attention during the trip.

Return by 4x4 to the kasbah.

Lunch included.

Free evening to enjoy the dunes of the Sahara.

Dinner.

After dinner we will depart FROM THE RECEPTION OF THE ALBERGUE for the north of Morocco overnight on route to Fez.

SATURDAY MAY 2nd, 2020 MERZOUGA - FEZ

Breakfast on route.

Arrival to Fez.

Morning Tour of the old medina of Fez with a local guide. The old Medina is a true labyrinth, with more than 9,400 streets, tall buildings, and winding and narrow pathways that allow little light to reach the floor. We will explore the mysteries and wonders that fill the city of Fez. Fez was founded in the IX century and boasts the oldest Medina in Morocco, as well as one of the oldest universities in the world. The city is divided into three parts, and still maintains traditions that were lost to the Occidental world decades ago, like the artisan hide tanning. Walking through the streets of Fez is like taking a trip back in time, where potters, founders, and artisans coexist with foreign visitors. The sights, sounds, and smells of Fez are unforgettable.

Check in and lunch at the hotel.

Free evening.

Free time for dinner in Fez (Optional dinner show)

SUNDAY MAY 3rd, 2020 FEZ SEVILLA

Breakfast at the hotel and check out.

Departure for sightseeing in the coastal village of Assilah.

Later we continue to Tanger Med where you will board the ferry to Algeciras.

Transfer to Seville and end of the tour.

Passport Control

It is obligatory to bring a valid passport that allows for more than one entrance into Spain.

Upon arrival to the port, you will be given a registration card for entrance to Morocco. Please fill in the information and give it to the police desk on board in order to receive your entry stamp.

It is very important that you stamp your passport along with the registration card before the ferry arrives to Morocco leaves the port. You passport will be returned to you stamped by the police.

Visas

Please consult the LIST OF COUNTRIES to see if you need a visa to enter Morocco (Spaniards, Members of the EU, U.S. and Japanese citizens do not need visas).

All citizens of non-EU countries should be sure that their passport allows for more than one entry into Spain in order to avoid problems with the border guards upon re-entry.

Bus

For the tours starting in Seville. The bus will leave from "La Torre del Oro" at 06:00 AM. Please arrive 15 minutes early in order to check in.

Meals

In Morocco there is vegetarian food, please inform the guide if you have any special dietary needs.

4 dinners, 2 lunches and 3 breakfasts are included on the tour. All other meals are not included, although the guide will provide you with information on alternative options.

Drinks are not included in any of the meals; you must pay the waiters directly.

Money

Although the euro is accepted almost everywhere, Morocco's Money is the Dirham. Approx. Exchange rate: 1 euro = 10,50 Dirham



Safety Suggestions

Don't use the word "Moro" as it offends the Moroccans. Use Moroccan or Marroquí.

Do not walk around by yourself at night; groups of 4 are better

Always ask before taking a picture of someone

Do not give out the particulars of your stay in the country (who, where, when)

Practical Information

We suggest the use of the **petit taxis** (blue with a yellow stripe) to move around the city, they hold up to 3 people and have taxi meters. If the driver does not start the meter, you should remind him to do so. The average trip should not cost more than 1 €.

Take your swimsuit just in case you want to enjoy a Hammam or take a dip at the beach or in the hotel pool. All tours will be conducted in Spanish

Be careful drinking tap water or drinks with ice cubes as it may provoke diarrhea or similar stomach problems **Haggling**: divide the initial price by 4 and let the final price be decided by the vendor.

There are many vegetarian menus available in Morocco

Tips are not included in the prices and 10% is customary in restaurants and .50 € per bag for luggage handling Alcoholic drinks are excessively expensive in restaurants so be aware. Also, it is illegal to drink any alcohol in the streets of Morocco.

Women traveling to Morocco are advised to wear discreet clothing

Alcohol and Tobacco

Alcohol and Tobacco are fairly expensive in Morocco. We suggest that you buy these products in the duty-free shop onboard the ferry. Keep in mind that these items can be exchanged for items and souvenirs while in Morocco.

Money, travelers checks and credit cards

We recommend that you bring cash because some cash machines tend to take cards and not return them and traveler's checks are not always accepted.

Always ask before each purchase, especially in bars and restaurants. Don't accept food or drinks that you have not ordered or without knowing the price.

Haggling and Bargaining are a big part of shopping in Morocco. However, there are basic prices of which you should be aware. Remember: they will always ask for a lot of Money at the beginning. Bargaining is the only way to get a good price.

At the end of the trip

You will be asked to fill out a questionnaire in order to rate your experience with us and to help us improve our services by giving us your suggestions. We would appreciate your cooperation in filling out these questionnaires and turning them in to the Tour Leader upon completion.
